


Add a tag to a device

Adding a tag to a device helps you organize devices within the ExtraHop system. You can search for a device by tag, or create a dynamic device group based on a tag.

Before you begin

[Create a device tag](#).

1. Log into the Web UI on the Discover or Command appliance.
2. Click the System Settings icon  and then click **Tags**.
3. Click a tag name in the table.
4. Click the field in the Add <tag name> to a device section.
5. Type the name of a device, an IP address, a MAC address, or a hostname.
6. Select a device name from the search results.
The device will appear on the page.
7. Optional: Repeat steps 4-6 to select additional devices.
8. Click **Save**.
9. Click **Done** to close the Tag Settings page.



Tip: You can also add a tag to a device from a protocol page. [Find a device](#) and then click the device name. From the device's protocol page, click **Properties** in the upper right corner and then select the **Tag** tab.
