

Analyze Lync Traffic

This procedure explains how to view Lync traffic in your network environment with an ExtraHop system.



Note: You must be able to access the ExtraHop Admin UI, which requires a user account with unlimited privileges.

Add SSL decryption key and protocols

- 1. From the ExtraHop Admin UI, in the System Configuration section, click Capture.
- 2. Click SSL Decryption.
- 3. In the SSL Decryption Keys section, click **Add Keys**.
- In the Add PEM Certificate and RSA Private Key section, on the Add SSL Keys page, type the following information:
 - Name: A user-friendly name for the key that you're adding.
 - Certificate: The certificate information for your Lync server.
 - Private Key: The private key information for your Lync server.
- 5. Click Add.
- 6. In the Encrypted Protocols section, click **Add Protocol**.
- 7. In the Add Encrypted Protocol section, click the Protocol drop-down and select SIP.
- 8. From the Key drop-down, select the private key you added previously in step 4.
- 9. In the Port field, type 5061
- 10. Click Add.
- 11. Repeat steps 6-10 and add HTTP as an encrypted protocol. The port number for HTTP is 443.

Next steps

Return to the ExtraHop Web UI and view the RTP, RTCP, and SIP pages for applications and devices of interest. Metrics that include Lync traffic are included.
